- o Your ticket will be used for all services. Please have it available to show the ushers. If you do not have a ticket, call the Temple office at (716) 836-6565.
- o All services that are in the Sanctuary will be live streamed. The link can be found on the TBZ website and the TBZ facebook page.
- o All services for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur will be held at Temple Beth Zion, 805 Delaware Avenue.  
(Our Rosh Hashanah Alternative service will be held at Becker Farms)

### SECURITY

- o **We take your safety and the security of our facilities seriously. While we work with local law enforcement and have private security on-site, we ask you to also be aware of your surroundings. If you see something that seems suspicious or out of place, please say something to a security officer, usher or a member of the TBZ staff. In addition, please remember to bring your tickets to each service you attend.**

### PARKING

- o Please respect the need to reserve parking in the Temple parking lot for those congregants who are 70 and older or who have handicap permits.
- o Those attending the 9:00am Rosh Hashanah and 9:00am Yom Kippur Children's services and programs may use the temple lot.
- o You may drop off passengers at the Delaware entrance or at the parking lot steps for all services. Please enter the lot from Barker Street and exit onto Linwood or Delaware.
- o On street parking will be available during all services
- o Parking instructions and a map are available.
- o We encourage carpooling or using the subway (from U.B. south campus to Summer-Best Station) to reduce congestion in the surrounding streets and lots.
- o If you are attending the late morning service, please arrive no earlier than 30 minutes before the service to help reduce congestion.
- o On Yom Kippur evening (Kol Nidre) and afternoon, parking will be at a premium within one block of TBZ.
